Question: Why should you study a PG program in the UK?

Answer: The United Kingdom is recognised globally for its academic excellence and delivering world-leading, quality research. Over 45% of international students in the UK are studying a postgraduate degree,

and most postgraduate degrees in the UK can be completed in one year. This offers greater value for money, enabling students to move on with their career more quickly. The UK also offers a graduate route visa, allowing international students to work for up to two years on completion of their qualification.

There are two main types of masters degree in the UK; taught and research. A masters degree is a second-level qualification, and in most instances requires the applicant to hold an undergraduate degree. Many choose to study a similar subject to their undergraduate degree, but some use postgraduate study as an opportunity to move into a field they have not studied previously.

Students choose to study in the UK for a number of reasons, these include:
